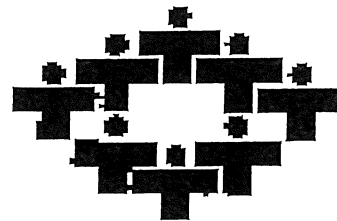

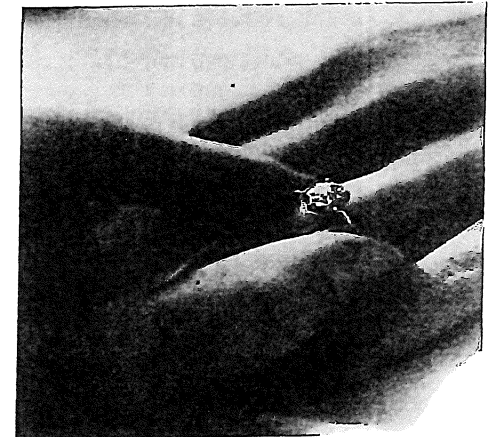

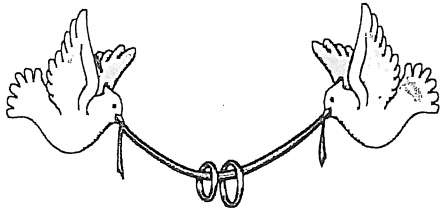

Marriage Preparation Process



It is the belief of the Church that when two people who are Christian marry, something distinctive happens. The man and woman, who commit themselves to a life long covenant of love, celebrate a Sacrament. And, as the Scriptures tell us, "they are no longer two, but one flesh" As your married life continues the sacramental character of your marriage is witnessed to the believing community.

By choosing to have a Church wedding, you are acknowledging that your spiritual preparation for the marriage is particularly important. Your values, prayer life, belief in God and His Commandments, and practice of your faith will be what supports you throughout your marriage. Since you are asking the Church to witness your marriage, it is important that you are practicing your faith. The Church asks that those who marry here attend Mass regularly (each Sunday), use the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and prepare prayerfully for marriage. The marriage preparation program is designed to support your preparation at all these levels.

1. You are invited to register in our parish.
2. The couple must attend the scheduled Marriage Orientation
3. **The Scheduling of a wedding is to be made at least six months in advance.**
4. The couple must schedule an appointment with the marriage coordinator, **Gloria Sandoval** to schedule the wedding date. (There is a \$150.00 deposit, non refundable, to reserve the date)
5. The couple must bring all appropriate Paper work (i.e. Sacramental certificates)
6. The couple will be assigned a Marriage Preparation Couple.

All marriages are scheduled for 12noon or 2pm on Saturday, please do not be late as frequently there are other services following (other marriage ceremonies, quinceañeras, or confessions). If the party arrives late, the priest reserves the right, at his discretion, to shorten the service as necessary, in order to be respectful to those attending later services.
